

Snow Swabs

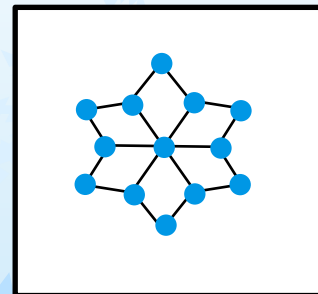
Let it snow....Inside!

To make this cool craft you'll need:

Cotton swabs (18 per snowflake), tacky glue, glitter, cardboard, waxed paper, and string

Instructions:

- 1 Cover your large piece of cardboard with waxed paper.
- 2 Lay 18 cotton swabs in the pattern shown on the right.
- 3 Place a glob of tacky glue on all the places where the swabs meet.
- 4 Sprinkle glitter on the glue.
- 5 Let dry overnight.
- 6 Hang around the house using the string.
- 7 Enjoy seeing snow whether or not there is real snow outside!



Pine Cone Bird Feeder

Help Feed the Birds!

To make this cool craft you'll need:

Pine cones, peanut butter*, birdseed, and string

Instructions:

- 1 Go outside and gather some pine cones. You will need one for each bird feeder, so decide how many you are going to want to make.
- 2 Smear some peanut butter all over the pine cones.
- 3 Roll the peanut butter covered pine cone in birdseed.
- 4 Tie a piece of string to the top end of the pine cone.
- 5 Hang it outside.
- 6 Watch as the birds enjoy your bird feeder!
